



## WHAT IS IT?

Quicket and Yoco have partnered to provide event organisers with an alternative to traditional card payment systems which allows event attendees to pay for goods within your event using any contactless enabled, Visa or Mastercard, bank card.



## HOW DOES IT WORK?

Quicket field services teams can load up your vendor's merchandise into the Yoco Point of Sale (POS) system and deploy the POS on the tablets with the Yoco Tap enabled card machines at each of your vendors within the event.

Many vendors are familiar with the Yoco POS and for those who aren't, our helpful staff will provide the brief training needed to get selling.

## WHY DOES THIS OFFER EXIST

A growing demand for fast, efficient payments at bars and vendors within events to reduce queue times has event organisers looking to contactless enabled card payment systems for assistance.

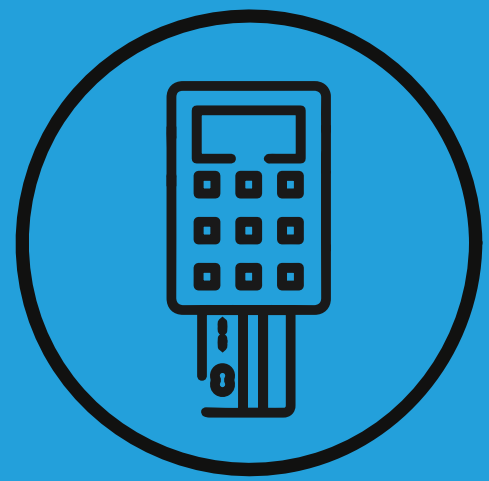


The Yoco|Quicket event payment platform is a lightweight solution that costs less to set up than a fully fledged cashless offering.

## WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS TO EVENT ORGANISERS AND ATTENDEES?

## HOW IS THIS DIFFERENT TO A NORMAL CASHLESS OFFERING

A fully-fledged cashless system works in remote environments with no internet connectivity and requires attendees to purchase a contactless-enabled wristband or card, onto which they load their funds at a top-up station, for use at vendors and bars.



The Yoco|Quicket offering only works in online environments, but removes the need for top-up stations and staff which makes it ideal for one day events in connected areas.

## ANYTHING ELSE I SHOULD KNOW?

With banks forcing the roll out of contactless enabled bank cards, many South Africans now have at least one contactless credit or debit card which can be used to transact at a Yoco Tap enabled card machine. Users with traditional chip and pin cards can also pay by dipping or swiping with Yoco. No more queuing at top-up stations, or buying unnecessary contactless cards.



## WHAT ARE THE COSTS?

Each event is different, and our offering aims to provide the most cost-effective solution for event organisers to accept card payments at their events. There are, however, device rental and transaction processing costs which can either be paid by the event organiser or absorbed by the on site vendors.
